Crating, Building Rules, Entry/Exit Info

- All Crating will be outside – no crating in the building
- Boxes, balls and props should be stored on the mat on the field
- Face Masks will be required in the building
- There will be plenty of sanitizer and cleaning supplies available
- To enter for racing please enter through the far door at the box end of the lanes
- To exit after race is complete exit through the door at the back of the lane
- There will be small swimming pool available to help cool off your dog

2. Schedule

Saturday

- 8:00 am: Building Opens
- 8:30 am: Measuring – Cindy will be demonstrating the new measuring device and there will be time for everyone to practice.
- 8:45 am: Captains Meeting – will be held outside (weather permitting)
- 9:00 am: Racing Begins
- Swimming and Mat Time will be available at the conclusion of racing. Sign up at the head table.
 - \$5 per Swim/Dock Diving Session (approximately 15 minutes)
 - \$5 per Mat Time (approximately 10 minutes).

Sunday

- 7:30 am: Building Opens
- 8:00 am: Racing Begins

3. Racing Information

With such a small tournament we have had to build in several half hour breaks to allow for enough rest time between races for dogs

Warm-ups will be 2 minutes (at least – although don't go crazy).

The Race Schedule includes approximate start times for each race and break. We will watch the clock and we will not start a race before that time on the schedule as the timing is critical to allow for proper rest. We will adjust as needed throughout the weekend.

Judges: Head Judge Tom Lamont with relief judges Cindy Henderson and Lorraine Messier

There will be line judges however no box judges – the head judge will make calls at the box with the assistance of the line judges as needed.

A 7th dog can be listed on the timesheets but is only allowed to warm-up, they can not race in any actual heats. The 7th dog must have a CRN and is subject to all rules during the warm-up period.

Remember no false starts. Tell the judge before warm-up ends if you would like a practice start.

All Divisions are a 4 of 4 format.

One point will be awarded for each heat one.

Placements based on number of heats won.
